HADASSAH, Jewish name of Esther, Esth. 2:7.

HADATTAH, probably an adjective qualifying Hazor, making it equivalent to New Hazor, Josh. 15:25.
HADES. 1. The unseen world, translated hell in A. V., but in the R. V. the word Hades is retained, Matt. 10:28; 11:23; 16:18; Luke 10:15; 16:23; Acts 2:27,31; Rev. 1:18; 6:8; 20:13,14.

2. **THE REALM, OR STATE, OF THE DEAD**: 2 Sam. 22:6. The sorrows of hell compassed me about; the snares of death prevented me;
Job 26:5. Dead things are formed from under the waters, and the inhabitants thereof.
Psa. 6:5. For in death *there is* no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks?
Psa. 17:15. As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness.
Psa. 30:9. What profit *is there* in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth?
Psa. 49:15. But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me.
Psa. 86:13. For great *is* thy mercy toward me: and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.
Psa. 88:10. Wilt thou shew wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise *and* praise thee? 11. Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? *or* thy faithfulness in destruction? 12. Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?
Psa. 115:17. The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence.
